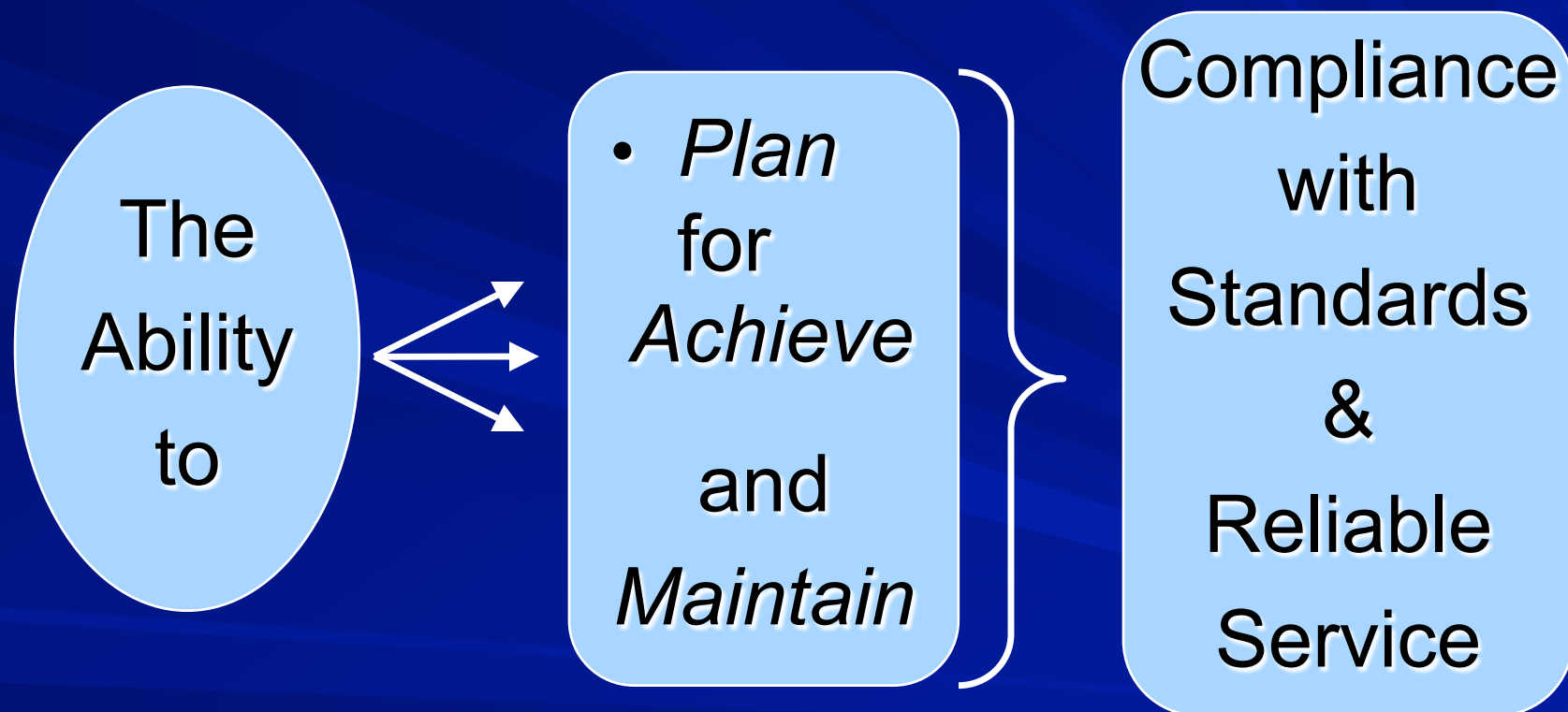
INTRODUCTION (AUWSSC)

- The Afghanistan Urban Water Supply and Sewerage Corporation (AUWSSC), a commercialised corporation owned by the Government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan (GIROA), has been granted liberal water supply policy and contracting powers by the Cabinet of Ministers, within the context of the water and environmental laws approved by Parliament in 2009 /1378(Declaration no 130) .
- AUWSSC has been approved as a National independent budget entity organisation by the President of Afghanistan on 11 February 2011(22/11/1390)(Declaration 6666).

Water has an economic value in all its competing uses and should be recognized as an economic good

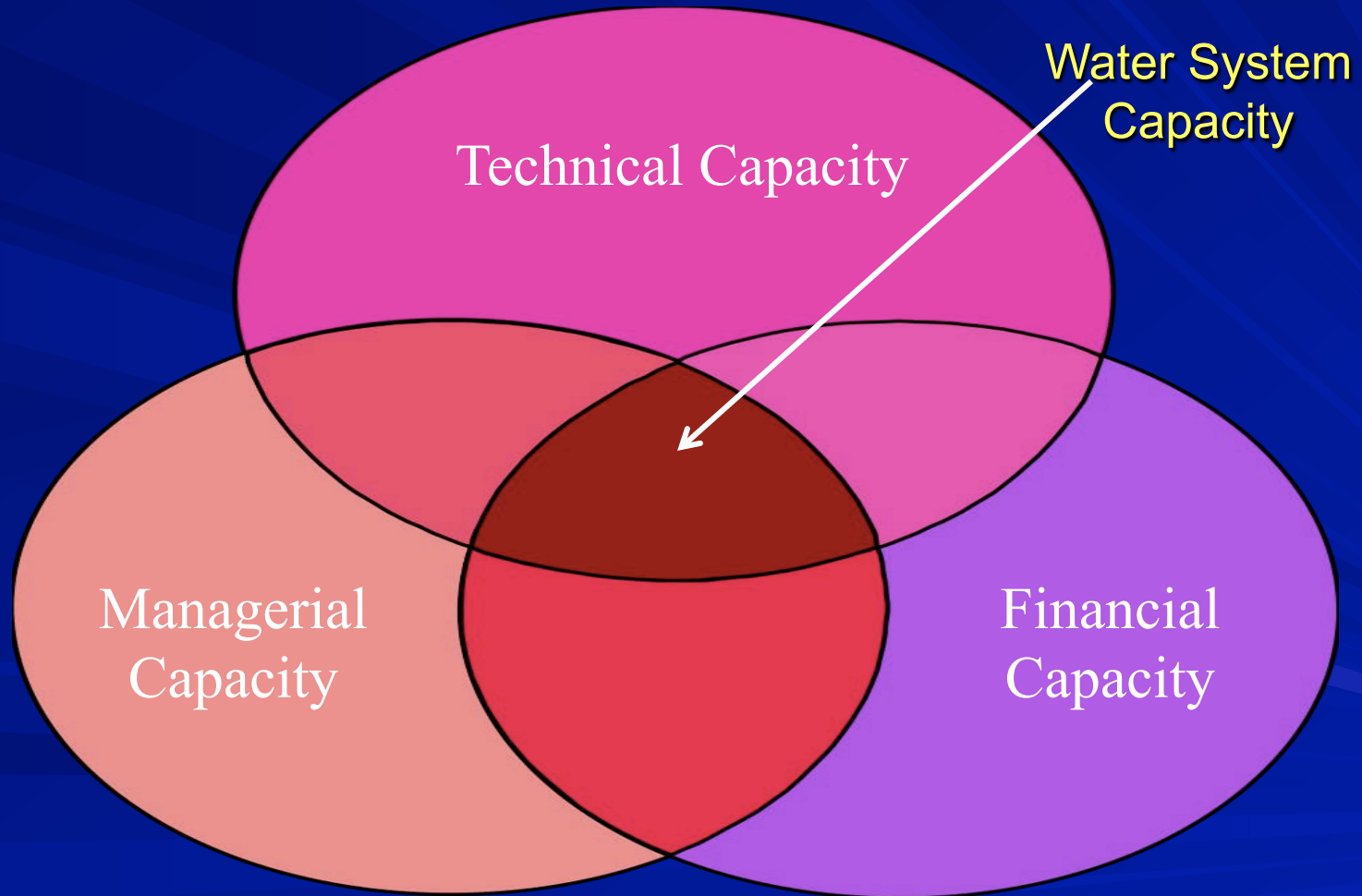
